CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 This Championship meet is open only to Wairarapa and Wellington Affiliated clubs except for Event 2 and 9
- 2 Swimmers competing in Event's 2 & 9 may not participate in **Swimming Club** relay teams
- 3 All events will be conducted as timed finals under the SNZ rules
- 4 Age of the swimmers will be as at 1 July 2013
- 5 Swimming up an age is permitted in all events **EXCEPT** 1, 14 & 15, which must have actual age group swimmers.
- 6 Swimmers may swim in both age group and open events.
- 7 Super 5 & Flying Squadron age groups are 9/under, 10/11, 12/13, 14/15, 16/over
- 8 Flying Squadron (Event 17) swimming order must be youngest first to oldest last
- 9 Clubs may enter more than one team for each of events 3-8 & 10-15
- 10 All Clubs are to each have a team manager present at the marshalling area to assist with identification of teams
- 11 **The age for the Golden Oldies is not less than 30 years. No other restrictions apply.**
- 12 Events 2-13 must have submitted names and times when entries are made. Names & times for Events 1, 14 & 15 plus any name changes for events 2-13, must be submitted by 12 [noon] on Friday 5 July 2013.
- 13 **Substitution for team members affected by illness, and the swimming order of that relay team only**, can be made up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. Failure to swim in the named order will result in disqualification of the team.
- 14 **Entry fees will be \$20.00 per team per event, \$10 per LTS team per events 2 & 9 \$10, the Golden Oldies will be free.**
- 15 **Entries close at 7.00pm on Monday 1 July 2013, no late entries accepted.** Entries to be forwarded to Operations@swimwn.co.nz, and to include a cfile or hvy file, a fee summary. Coach and Team Managers list to be provided. **Swim School entries on attached form provided, either scanned and emailed or faxed to 04 5600381 Attn. Henrietta.**
- 16 **Entry fees of \$20 per event accompanied by a fee summary are to be made by Monday 1 July 2013.** Direct bank deposit or Electronic payments can be made to; **WPT 030502-0166158-00**. The conditions of this meet are that all entry fees are to be paid in advance.
- 17 **There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the circulation of psych sheets on Tuesday 2 July 2013.**
- 18 Pool door fees are payable on entry as \$2.00 per spectator. Officials and Coach/Managers in the ratio of 1 per 4 Club Teams will be free on sign in at the door. Spectator Programmes will be 1.00.
- 19 Medals for places 1-3 inclusive will be presented at the end of the meet, along with the Event Trophies. All team members will be expected to attend the presentation. **Current trophy holders are to ensure that the trophies are cleaned, engraved and returned to Henrietta Latham by Friday 28 June 2013, at Pelorus House, 93 Hutt Park Road, Seaview.**
- 20 The Organisers reserve the right to amend the programme in any way and to **limit** entries. Swimming Wellington will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.
- 21 All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules
