SECTION TWO: Event Information

2.1 Event Details

The 2014 Victorian Age Championships will be held at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre (MSAC) from Saturday 14 December to Thursday 19 December 2013.

2.2 Program of Events

The 2014 Victorian Age Championships will consist of 182 events conducted over 6 days.

Please note, there have been a number of changes to the order of events for this year, please refer to Appendix A.

All relay events will be swum as Timed Finals in the finals sessions.

The following events will also be swum as timed finals with the fastest heat swum in the finals session:

- Event 27 – Boys 14-15 yrs 1500 Freestyle
- Event 58 - Girls 13 & Under 800 Freestyle
- Event 65 – Boys 13 & Under 800 Freestyle
- Event 128 – Boys 13 & Under 400 Freestyle
- Event 129 – Girls 13 & Under 400 Freestyle
- Event 138 – Boys 16-18 yrs 1500 Freestyle
- Event 153 – Girls 16-18 yrs 800 Freestyle
- Event 178 – Girls 13 & Under 400 IM
- Event 179 – Boys 13 & Under 400 IM
- Event 180 – Girls 14-15 yrs 800 Freestyle

All other Events will be swum as heats and finals.

Warm up finishes 10 minutes prior to the competition start time (except on 14 December).

2.2.2 Medal Allocation

Medals will be awarded in accordance with *Appendix B – Competition Bylaw Schedule A.4*

2.2.3 Multi Age Group Events

In the following events there will only be one set of medals & one point score:

- 13/U 400 free and 400 IM
- 13/U 800 free
- 14-15 800 and 1500 free
- 16-18 800 and 1500 free

2.3 Qualifying Times

All qualifying times must have been achieved in a 50m pool. Converted times will not be accepted. Qualifying times must have been achieved after 1st January 2012.

2.4 Entry Process

Entries for the 2014 Victorian Age Championships will open on 7 October 2013. **Entries will close at 5.00pm on Monday 2 December 2013.**

Age groups are determined by the swimmer's age as at 14 December 2013 (first day of competition).

2.4.1 Entry Methods

All entries must be lodged using one of the following methods:

Online Entry

Visit the [Events Calendar](#) on Swimming Victoria's website to enter online by clicking on the Individual Entries button. This is the preferred method of entry. Please attempt this method before submitting a hard copy entry or Team Manager (TM) / Meet Manager (MM) file.

Please note if you are entering using a split or relay lead off time you will need to enter via a hard copy entry form or TM / MM file.

Team Manager | Meet Manager File

MM & TM entry files are only accepted on behalf of a club, not an individual. MM & TM files can be accessed via the Events Calendar on the Swimming Victoria website.

Hard Copy Entry

Please attempt entering online before submitting a hard copy entry. The hard copy form can be downloaded from the event page of the Swimming Victoria website. Please note there is a \$5 admin fee per hard copy form, (excluding if you are using a split or relay lead off time.)

2.4.2 Split or Relay Lead Off Times

If you are entering using a split or relay lead off time you will need to enter via a hard copy form. See 2.4.1 for further details.

2.4.3 Entry Fees

Entry Fees are: \$16 per individual event
 \$46 per relay event
 \$11.50 per relay only swimmer

Swimming Victoria will invoice clubs that enter via a TM or MM file. Do not submit payment until your club receives this invoice.

2.4.4 Relay Entries

It is imperative that clubs submit realistic relay entry times to allow for appropriate seeding. Swimming Victoria has the right to ask clubs to verify the makeup of relay times. **A reminder that clubs will be fined if qualifying times are not reached.** Hard copy entries and TM/MM files will be accepted for relays.

All relay only swimmers must be listed on the online Club Summary Form prior to closing date.

Please note: while clubs are restricted to entering two teams per event, there are no restrictions on the number of relays an individual swimmer can compete in.

Club Packages

2.4.5 Applying for Club Packages

Each club must submit a [Club Summary Form](#) outlining the club's coaching, support staff and relay only swimmers. If a relay only swimmer is not pre recorded they will not be able to compete.

This information will ensure that all personnel accessing pool deck are authorised to do so. The completion of the Club Summary Form will also ensure that Swimming Victoria staff will be able to promptly manage any queries relating to your club's entries or similar prior to the meet.

Club package applications must be lodged to Swimming Victoria using the Club Summary Form found on the event page on the Swimming Victoria website. Club package applications will close at **5:00pm on Monday 2 December 2013.**

Clubs can apply for up to two free Team Manager Passes. A \$25 fee will apply to any additional Team Manager passes requested. Swimming Victoria will consider a club's entry numbers before providing additional Team Manager Passes.

Club packages will consist of athlete accreditation, team manager accreditation, withdrawal slips & relay forms.

2.4.6 Collecting Club Packages

Club packages can be collected from the Swimming Victoria office on Level 3 at MSAC from 11am on Thursday 12 December. The accreditation desk will also be open from the commencement of warm up on Saturday 14 December.

2.5 By-Laws

[Swimming Victoria By-Laws apply.](#) A copy of the By-Laws can be obtained from the Swimming Victoria website. These By-Laws stipulate that refunds are not provided unless an entry is rejected. Refunds are not provided for any other reason; including medical grounds.

If less than 4 entries are received for any event that event will **not** be conducted.

2.5.1 90 Day Rule

The following is an extract from the Swimming Victoria Competition Bylaws – Section 1.8 Entries:

1.8.3 Registered members of a club affiliated with SV (or a border club as defined in Schedule D of SV's General By Laws) may enter Victorian Championship Meets if they:-

- a) Have been registered with that club for at least 90 days prior to the closing date for the meet being entered or from the commencement of the current season, whichever is the less.

The cut-off date applicable for this rule for each Victorian Championship meet will be declared in the conditions of entry for that particular meet.

OR

- b) have joined a club affiliated with SV for the first time and have not previously been a member of any other Club or Federation affiliated to FINA.

1.8.4 A competitor whose registration with a Club affiliated with SV is not processed prior to this cut-off date will swim as unattached.

Unattached swimmers do not earn points but they are eligible to win medals and may be eligible for other individual awards.

1.8.5 All swimmers not included in 1.8.3 or 1.8.4 will be regarded as visiting competitors.

Please note, the '90 day' date for these Championships is 3 September 2013.

2.5.2 Visitors

The following is an extract from the Swimming Victoria Competition Bylaws Section 1.9 State and Country Championships:

- 1.92 No more than two (2) visiting competitors shall be permitted to swim in the final of either a State or Country Age Group Championship. This does not include members of Border Clubs referred to in Schedule D of the General Bylaws.

2.5.3 Relays

The following is an extract from the Swimming Victoria Competition Bylaws Section 1.11 Relay Events:

1.11.1 For all team events, a team list on the appropriate form must be submitted. Separate team sheets are required for heats and finals. It is permissible to change the team members between heats and finals, members may not be interchanged between teams. Members of teams disqualified in a heat are precluded from competing in that final.

1.11.2 Each club is permitted to enter a maximum of two teams in any one relay event in the Victorian Long Course & Short Course Championships.

1.11.4 Relay team sheets must be submitted to the Chief Recorder prior to the starting time for the session in which the event is to be swum.

Please note: Relay swimmers will be required to present their accreditation when they marshal. Their names will be checked against those on the team sheets submitted.

Team managers, coaches and swimmers are reminded that relay team members need to swim in the order listed on their team sheet.

2.5.4 Withdrawals

The following is an extract from the Swimming Victoria Competition Bylaws Section 1.2 Withdrawals:

- 1.12.1 Competitors wishing to withdraw from a final shall do so in writing, signed by the competitor or an authorised representative within thirty (30) minutes of the posting of the finalist list for that event.
- 1.12.2 A competitor not having withdrawn as specified, and who does not compete in the Final shall be deemed a late withdrawal, and as such, shall be debarred from competing in his next individual event.
- 1.12.3 If the late withdrawal occurs in the competitor's last individual event of the competition he shall be fined.
- 1.12.4 The penalties for late withdrawal may be reviewed if there are medical grounds or the competitor can prove hardship for not competing. A competitor who is added to an event final following the withdrawal of another competitor, and who can show that he was unaware of the change may claim hardship.

Withdrawal forms will be available at the Sport Information Desk and from the Technical Director. Completed forms should be lodged with the Technical Director.

2.6 Medical Certificates & Taping

All competitors, parents and coaches need to be aware that Swimming Victoria enforces the FINA Rule relating to Medical Taping:

SW10.8 provides that any sort of tape on the body is subject to approval of the Sport Medicine Committee.

Swimming Victoria is implementing this rule in modified form in that we require a certificate from a medical professional (doctor, physio, etc) specifying why the taping is required.

The certificate must be presented to the Technical Director of the Meet BEFORE the swimmer wearing the taping begins competing at that meet. It need only be presented once for the duration of that meet.

The certificate must be dated and will be acceptable by Swimming Victoria for 30 days from the date of issue. The certificate should state that the swimmer is fit to swim and that the taping does not provide any competitive advantage to the swimmer.

The Technical Director will check that a certificate is presented and further that the taping does not provide any advantage to the competitor.

2.7 Accreditation

An accreditation system will be implemented by Swimming Victoria to provide access control at the 2013 Victorian Age Championships. All athletes and team managers must wear their accreditation in a visible position whilst in the competition area. Coaches must display their current asctaVIC licence at all times.

All athletes will automatically be provided with accreditation, team managers must apply. See 2.4.5 for further details.

2.8 Parking

Swimming Victoria recommends the use of public transport to travel to and from the MSAC.

If required, paid parking is available in the lakeside car park which is located off Aughtie Drive. For further information please visit the MSAC website www.msac.com.au.

2.9 Pre Event Training

Swimming Victoria has organised training for clubs who wish to make use of MSAC. Up to seven lanes will be available in the Outdoor Pool on the following days:

- Thursday 12 December, 3pm – 6pm
- Friday 13 December, 9am – 11am & 3pm – 6pm

2.10 Warm Up Procedures

Warm-up in competition pool will cease 10 mins prior to start of session. Please follow lane signage during warm up periods. During sessions, there will be 10 25m lanes in the indoor pool available for warm up and cool down.

2.11 Opening Ceremony

An Opening Ceremony will be held before the finals session on Day 1.

2.12 Medal Presentations

Dress requirements for medal presentations are tracksuit, preferably Club or State, or Club or State T-shirt with appropriate tracksuit pants or shorts. Footwear is optional. Towels and/or head wear are not to be worn. Swimming Victoria requests the cooperation of all swimmers and coaches in the presentation of medals. Medal presentation for finals will generally be held one event after the following event has been swum. Finalists should use the baskets provided on pool deck to store their clothing. At the conclusion of each final, place getters are to remain on the pool concourse, dry off and wait for the presentation of medals.

2.13 Age Group Champions

Age Group Champions are awarded to the male and female in each age group category who achieve the highest points score. Presentation of Age Group Champions will take place at the conclusion of the finals session on Day 6 to all Age Champions. The following conditions will apply in determining the winners of the Awards:

- Swimmers must be a registered member of a Victorian Club at the start of the Victorian Championship.
- Swimmers will be given points for all positions in finals of individual events.
- If two or more swimmers of the one age and gender obtain an equal number of points, the Championship Award will be awarded to the swimmer who has obtained the greatest number of first placings in finals. If there is still equality, a decision will be made based on the number of second placings, etc.

Please note: there are no Swimmer of the Meet Awards for Victorian Age Championships.

2.14 Coaches Seating

Limited Coaches seating will be available on pool deck. Alternatively there will be seating roped off in the grand stand for coaches only.

2.15 Ticketing

Tickets are only available to purchase at the door. Prices per session are as follows:

Adults	\$8.00
Child	\$5.00

2.15.1 Series Passes

Series Passes will be available for purchase closer to the event on the Swimming Victoria website. This includes 10 entry passes for \$60.

2.15.2 Companion Cards

Swimming Victoria is a Companion Card Affiliate. If a Companion Card is presented at our event, activity or meet, it is because the cardholder is a person who, due to their disability, requires attendant care type support from a companion in order to participate at our venue or event. Swimming Victoria will recognise it and issue a Companion (second) ticket for the cardholder's companion at no charge; this complies with existing anti-discrimination legislation.

2.16 Programs

Event programs will be available for purchase from the Sport Information Desk during the event. Finals programs will be available for sale during warm up for each finals session.

2.17 Timekeepers

In addition to the ongoing support provided by our Swimming Victoria officials, the smooth running of this meet is also reliant on volunteer timekeepers. All clubs are encouraged to identify parents or friends who can assist with timekeeping duties for this meet. All clubs will receive a timekeeper's roster closer to the event date.

On the competition days, all timekeepers should report to the timekeepers' desk situated on pool deck near the AOE Room 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the session. Three free entry passes will be distributed per lane at the conclusion of each session.

2.18 Lost Property

At the conclusion of each session, all property left on seats will be removed from the grandstand and handed in to the MSAC reception.
