The FINA points of the entry times of events entered by swimmers will be used for selecting the Top 10 swimmers

## The Wheel of Pain

(Stroke/distance & lane drawn on the night)
Top 10 Male and Female swimmers
Race for the \$50 cash prizes with a
Chocolate sweepstake for the rest

Session 1: 9.00am warm up / 9.30am start

Session 2: 5.00pm warm up / 5.30pm start







The Meet will conclude with The Wheel of Pain (free entry) where the Top 10 swimmers (male and female based on Fina points) will compete for two \$50 cash prizes in a mystery race decided by fate.

Also running is the Choco Sweepstake...... back the winner and you win too!

- The meet will be conducted under SNZ Rules and local rules as applicable.
- All events will be timed finals, with over the top starts.
- Age is as at the day of the meet. Age groups for swimming are 9 & under, 10/11yrs, 12/13 yrs, 14/15 yrs, 16 yrs & over, or open, as in the events list. Scoring will be done after the meet by SwimWn in the Signature format.
- There is no limit on the number of events that can be entered by swimmers, but in accordance with the SW Signature
  Meet Rules, only one NT (no time) entry per swimmer will be accepted. Times are to be submitted as long course
  actual or converted shortcourse.
- Swimmers must pre-enter Events 59 and 60 with their initial entries to be eligible for selection in the Wheel of Pain
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming rules. They must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
- The organisers will if necessary alter the programme and/or refuse entries, to allow the meet to finish within the allotted time. The organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage during the period of the meet.
- Entries close on Saturday 15 November 2014 and are to be e-mailed as a cfile, with swimmer entry by name and entry fee reports, to Pam Edwards racesec@capitalswim.co.nz.
- Entry fees are \$8.00 per swim (except for The Wheel of Pain, which is free to enter). Electronic or manual payments from Clubs are to be made to 03-0521-0208931-00 (GST no. 60-217-424) prior to the start of the meet.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the circulation of the psych sheets on Tuesday 18 November.

- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti Doping Rules.
